INFORMATION TO KNOW TO FILL OUT A MAIL IN BALLOT

Once you apply for an absentee ballot, you'll be able to check your status at govoteky.com.

When you receive the ballot in the mail, the packet will contain:

- 3 envelopes: one outer envelope, a middle envelope and an inner envelope called a security envelope
- Ballot instructions
- Ballot

Read the ballot instructions thoroughly.

- Take your ballot out and mark it.
- Bubble in everything effectively and correctly.
- If you make a mistake using a pencil, erase it completely and then bubble in the selection you would like. If you're using a pen and you mark the wrong choice, bubble in the choice that you do want and then circle that choice to show voter intent.

Then, you're going to fold the ballot in half, place it inside the inner yellow security envelope.

- Leave the flap that is on that envelope on. Do not detach that flap.
- On that flap, you will find a place for you to sign. It is recommended that you use a signature that closely represents your driver's license of voter registration signature.
- Sign and seal that inner yellow security envelope.

Put the signed and sealed yellow envelope inside the outer white envelope.

- Take that yellow envelope and put it in the outer white envelope.
- Sign your name on the outside top left hand corner of the outer white envelope.
- Seal the outer white envelope.

You have 3 options to return your ballot which in now sealed in the outer white envelope.

- You can put it in the mail. It is already postage paid and does not need postage/stamps.
 - It must be postmarked on or by 11/3/20.
- Deliver it to a county clerk's office by 6pm on 11/3/20.

 - You can reach out to your county clerk to find out where that box will be.
